# ADN ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- APPLY and get accepted to OCtech.
- MUST HAVE a 2.5 cumulative GPA from the last college where 12 or more credit hours were completed (not including developmental or remedial courses).
- MEET one of the following criteria:
  - ☐ SAT: 26 in Reading and 480 in Math
  - ☐ ACT: 19 in Reading and 17 in Math
  - ☐ TEAS: 65 in both Reading and Math (within 5 years)
  - ☐ Accuplacer: 71 in Reading and 25 in Math EA (within 5 years)
  - ☐ Accuplacer Next-Gen: 250 in Reading and 237 in Math QAS (within 5 years)
- COMPLETE BIO 210 and 211 within 7 years with a C or higher or have BIO 211 in progress.
- HAVE a current CNA, LPN, EMT, MA, Paramedic or PCT certification/license or certificate of completion from an accredited program within 7 years of program start date.

Other healthcare certifications may be accepted at the discretion of the Dean of Nursing.

You must pass a national background check and drug test upon acceptance to the program and before starting classes. Clinical sites may require additional background and drug testing during the course of your enrollment. Prior criminal convictions may affect your eligibility for licensure.

Applicants who have had 2 or more Nursing and Health Science program attempts (withdrawal and/or failure) within 3 years of the program start date are ineligible to apply.

# **EARLY ACCEPTANCE** WITH A MINIMUM SCORE OF 30 POINTS OR MEET GUARANTEED ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS.

## **GUARANTEED ADMISSION**

You are eligible for GUARANTEED ADMISSION if you meet all admission requirements above and complete all 8 general education courses (BIO 210, BIO 211 (both within 7 years with a B or higher) BIO 225, ENG 101, MAT 102/105 or higher, AHS 210 or BIO 240, PSY 201 and Humanities Elective) with a minimum 2.75 calculated GPA and at least a minimum grade of C in each course.

We encourage you to apply for our Health Science and Nursing programs when you are most competitive. The application is available in the D2L Virtual Advising Center. Be sure to complete the entire application packet. Incomplete packets will be rejected, and you will be unable to resubmit your application in the same application period.
