ADN FLEX ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- **APPLY and get accepted to OCtech.**
 Send in ALL official transcripts.
Transcripts take up to two weeks to be received and evaluated.
- **HAVE a current LPN license or be enrolled in the final summer semester of OCtech's PN program.**
(December grades not eligible for current application.)
- **MUST HAVE a 2.5 cumulative GPA from the last college attended where 12 or more credit hours were completed (not including developmental or remedial courses).**
- **COMPLETE all general education courses with a grade of C or higher. BIO 210, BIO 211, BIO 225, AHS 210 or BIO 240, ENG 101, MAT 102 or higher, PSY 201 and a humanities elective.**
- **PASS the ATI RN Fundamentals exam with a Level Two through the OCtech Testing Center within two years of current application deadline.**
- **ACHIEVE 80% proficiency on the Drug Calculations exam through the OCtech Testing Center within two years of current application deadline.**
- **MEET one of the following criteria:**
 SAT: 480 in Math AND either 26 in Reading or 480 in Reading/Writing
 ACT: 19 in Reading and 17 in Math
 TEAS: 65 in both Reading and Math (within 5 years)
 Accuplacer Next-Gen: 250 in Reading and 237 in Math QAS (within 5 years)

You must pass a national background check and drug test upon acceptance to the program and before starting classes. Clinical sites may require additional background and drug testing during the course of your enrollment. Prior criminal convictions may affect your clinical placement and eligibility for licensure.

Applicants who have had 2 or more Nursing and Health Science program attempts (withdrawal and/or failure) within 1 year of the program start date are ineligible to apply.

We encourage you to apply for our Health Science and Nursing programs when you are most competitive. After being accepted as a student at OCtech, meet with an advisor for guidance on completing the competitive application process. The competitive application can be found in Self-Service under the Academics tab. Please ensure that you complete the entire application packet. Incomplete packets will be rejected, and you will be unable to resubmit your application in the same application period.
